Permission Slip for AP Testing

Most of the Advanced Placement Exams for Ryan High School students this year will be administered at Ryan High School. However, some exams may be given at Denton High School or Guyer High School. Testing locations will be announced in mid-April.

Students need to be at their testing location by 7:30 for morning exams and 11:45 for afternoon exams. The school does not provide transportation for students to or from AP testing sites.

Students will be dismissed from morning exams by 12:15. Students who do not have other AP Exams scheduled in the afternoon will not be required to return to the school campus. Similarly, students taking afternoon exams do not have to come to school on the morning of the afternoon exam. Afternoon exams usually end by 5:00 p.m.

Please place a check in the box by **each** scenario that you approve for your child:

- My child **has** my permission to drive his/her car to another testing site.
- My child **has** my permission ride with another student to another testing site.
- My child **has** my permission to drive his/her car to leave campus before/after testing.
- My child **has** my permission ride with another student to leave campus before/after testing.
- My child **does not have** my permission to drive his/her car or ride with another student to or from testing (parent is responsible for student transportation to and from testing).
- My child **does not have** my permission to leave campus before/after testing. Student will attend all classes when not in testing.

I understand that cell phones, smart watches, PDAs, MP3 players, pagers, and any other electronic or communication devices are prohibited in the exam room. If a student is observed using any of these devices during testing or during breaks, the student **will be dismissed from the exam room**, and the device will be confiscated. Confiscated devices may be returned to the parent on the day following testing according to the rules in the DISD Student Handbook
