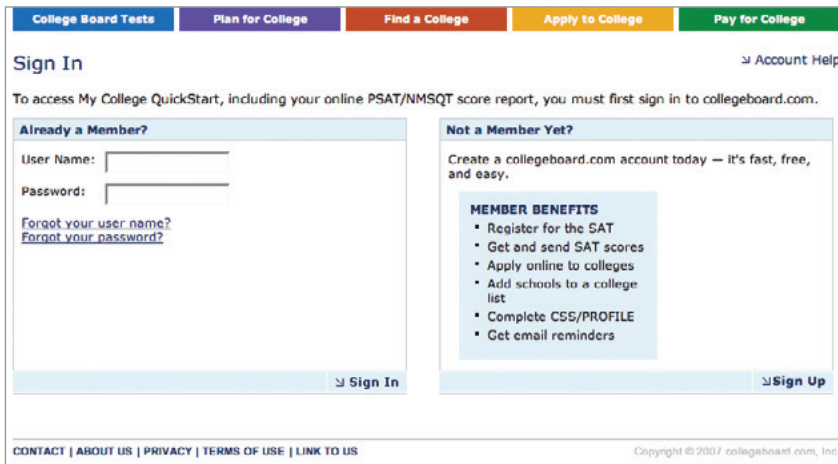

Before You Begin	<p>Students will need to have a valid e-mail address prior to creating a collegeboard.com account. If you do not have one, a variety of sources for free e-mail accounts can be found on the Internet. Some examples include yahoo.com, hotmail.com, msn.com, and aol.com.</p> <p>Note: Using the same e-mail address for multiple collegeboard.com accounts is discouraged. The student's e-mail address is a vital communication link between the College Board and the student.</p>

- Open your Internet browser and navigate to the URL, **www.collegeboard.com/quickstart**.
