

## Getting Started with eBooks in Destiny Discover

**Note:** This quick reference guide is for Follett eBook users who do not use Destiny® Library Manager™. With Destiny Discover™, it is easy to find, check out and read eBooks.

### Log in

#### Accessing Destiny Discover


The way you access Destiny Discover depends on how it's set up at your school. Use the instructions for one of the following options.

#### Option #1: Access Destiny Discover from a link on your school, library or class webpage

1. From the Login page, type your **Username** and **Password**.
2. Click **Login**.

#### Option #2: Go to destinydiscover.com


1. From any browser, go to [destinydiscover.com](http://destinydiscover.com).
2. Use the **Location** drop-down to select your state or province.
3. In the **School** field, type the first few letters of your school's name. When your school appears in the suggestions, select it.
4. Click **Go!**.
5. From the Login page, type your **Username** and **Password**.
6. Click **Login**.

### Option #3: Use the Destiny Discover app

1. From your mobile device (phone, tablet, etc.), launch the Destiny Discover app.
2. Use the **Location** drop-down to select your state or province.
3. In the **School** field, type the first few letters of your school's name. When your school appears in the suggestions, select it.  
**Note:** Steps 2 and 3 only need to be completed the first time you log in or if you need to select a different school.
4. If you are logging in with a username and password on a private/safe/secure device and want to automatically log in next time you open the app, select **Remember me on this device**.  
**Note:** This step is required to access downloaded Follett eBooks and Follett audiobooks when you are offline.
5. To log in with a username and password, tap **Log In**.  
**Note:** You can browse the Catalog by clicking **Browse as Guest**.
6. Type your Username and Password, and then tap **Submit**.

Do any of the following:

- Look at a book cover to see its availability.
- Click the cover to open an eBook.
- Click or Info (depending on the view selected) to access the title's Overview page for more information.

## Check out

### There are three ways to check out eBooks:

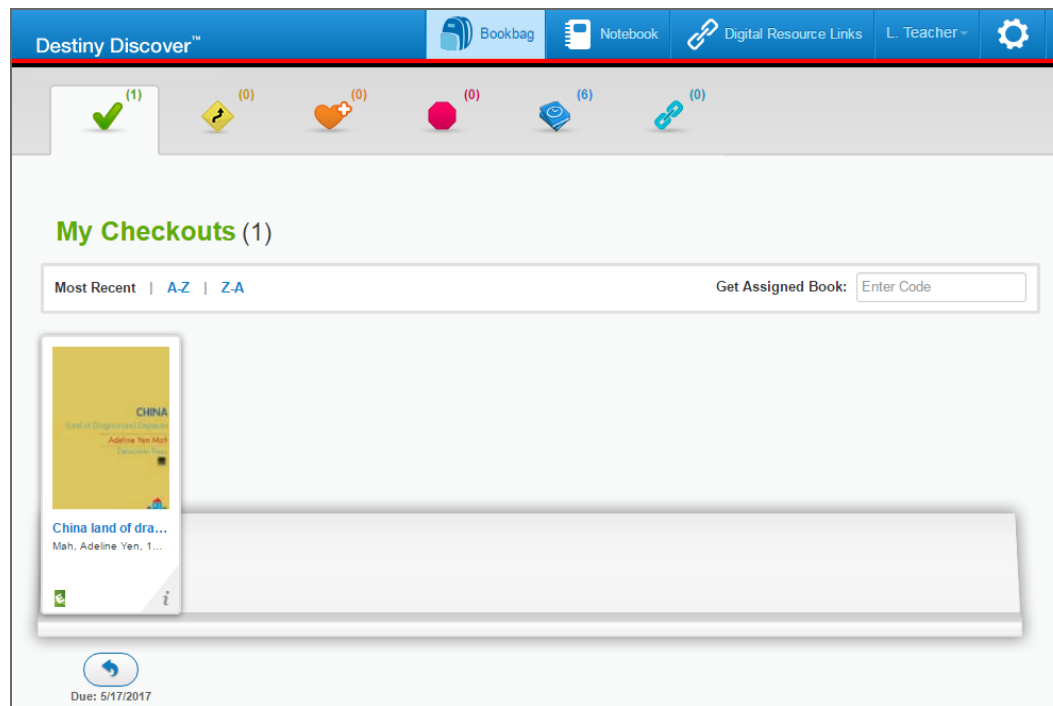
- From a title's Overview page: Click **Checkout/Hold**.
- From the search results (List view only): Click **Checkout/Hold** next to the title. **Note:** You must be logged in, and there must be available copies, for the checkout button to appear.
- From an open eBook: Click **Book**, or select  > **Check Out Title**.

If there are no available copies of a title and your school lets you place holds, click **Checkout/Hold** to place a hold.

## Read

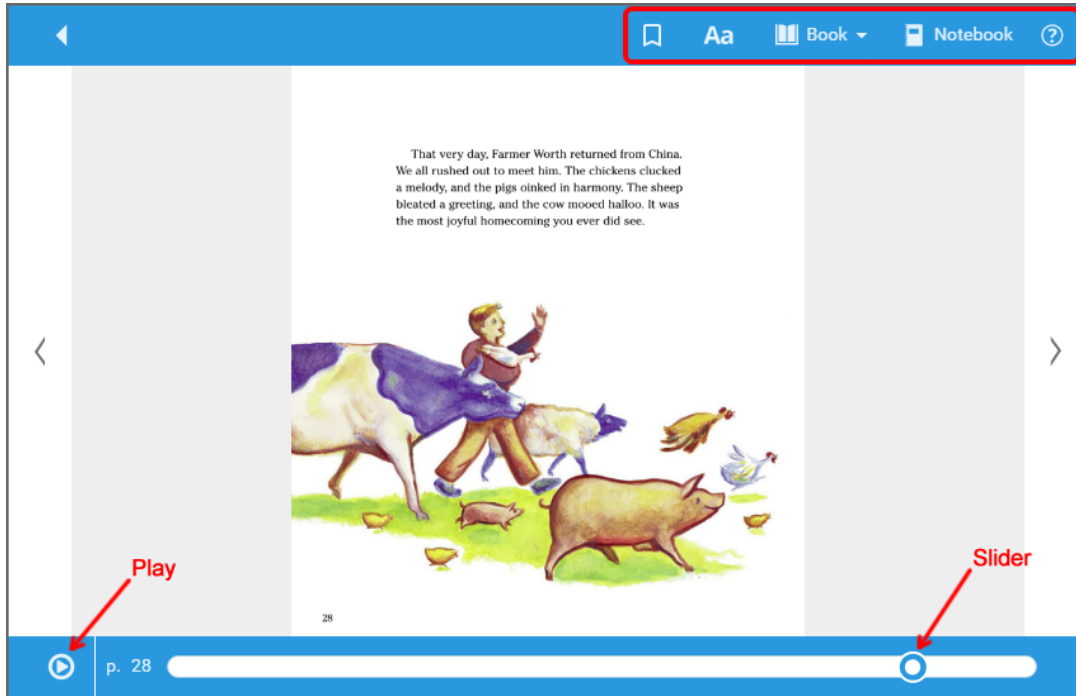
### To open a checked-out eBook:


1. From the top toolbar, click **Bookbag**.
2. From the **My Checkouts** tab, click the cover.



3. Do the following:

- Use the toolbar to access bookmarks, display options, information about the title, your notes and more.
- Use the slider or the forward and back arrows to turn the pages.




**Note:** If an eBook has text-to-speech capabilities, a 'play' option  appears at the bottom of the book.

## Take notes, make highlights and use the dictionary

Whether you check out an eBook or just open it, you can create and save highlights and notes. Publisher permissions determine whether these options are available.

### Bookmarks:





Click  on any page to mark a place in the eBook you want to come back to later.

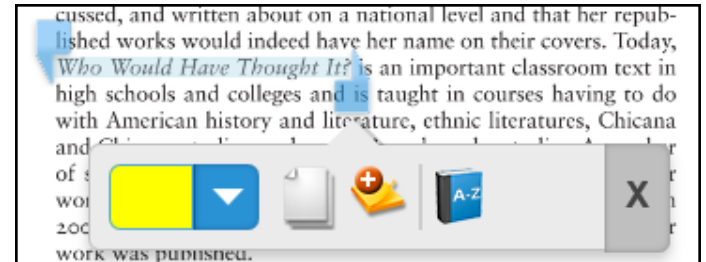
### Highlight and note tools:


To select a word, click and hold on it.

To select more than one word, click and hold on the first word you want to include. The word becomes shaded blue, and quotation marks appear. While still holding, drag your mouse over the rest of the words or sentences.

When you release your mouse button, a toolbar displays additional options:



- Click  to select a highlight color. Then, click that color to apply the highlight.
- Click  to copy your selection and paste it into another document.
- Click  to add a note to content you already highlighted.
- Click  to look up the meaning of the selected word.



To access your notes and bookmarks, click **Notebook** or . View the notes for the current title, or select **Titles > All** to see all of your notes, even if the eBook is not available.

## Return

Checked-out Follett eBooks and Follett Audiobooks are automatically returned on their due date. To return or renew an eBook early, do one of the following:

- From Destiny Discover: Click **Bookbag**, and then click  under the eBook you want to return.
- From an open eBook: Click **Book**, or select  **>Return Title**.

## Read offline from your mobile device

The Destiny Discover app lets you download an eBook while you are online that you can access later offline. It is available for iOS devices, Android devices with access to Google Play, Nook HD, Nook HD+, Kindle Fire HD, and Mac and Windows laptops.
