Load bus: 8:20 am

9:30-2:20, time to swim

What to Bring:

- Towel, sunscreen, money for purchasing snacks at the park. Dry clothes for the ride home. If you can bring an ice chest and water bottles, please let me know.
- Bring your instrument, music, and all supplies (shoulder rest, rosin, etc.).
- Bring your orchestra t-shirt and jeans to change into (or just wear over your bathing suit). We will be performing after we swim.

What to wear:

- **Guys** – Swim trunks that are like shorts. Nothing too short that would fail dress code policy.
- **Girls** – You have 2 options. Option #1: Wear a one piece bathing suit or tankini. Make sure everything is covered. Option #2: Wear a 2 piece bathing suit with a shirt over it. (Shirt must be worn the entire time).

Safety: Even though the park is only open to school groups while we're there, students will be required to check in at certain times throughout the day with their assigned parent chaperone. The check-in times will be given to the students upon arrival. Failure to make check-ins in a timely manner may result in the student having to sit out for a period of time or the rest of the day. Ms. McCane will have the emergency contact numbers of every student and all parent chaperones will be asked to carry a cell phone to contact Ms. McCane in case of emergency.

- You may bring a cell phone on this trip, or plan on sharing with someone in your group. We will call parents when we are on the way home so they can be waiting for us at McMath when we get back.
- Please be on time for check-ins, and follow all rules to ensure a safe and fun trip!
- You are representing McMath Middle School when you are in public. Be polite, follow all rules, be respectful of your chaperone, and have fun!
