If you keep playing all the way through high school you could be skilled enough to study music as a major in college, get a scholarship to college, or become a professional musician or professional music teacher.



Jimi Hendrix (1942-1970) Famous rock star, pioneer of the electric guitar. He played the <u>viola</u>.

Woodrow Wilson (1856-1924) 28th President of the United States. Played the <u>violin</u>.

Benjamin Franklin (1706-1790) Helped draft the Declaration of Independence. Also played guitar and <u>violin</u>.

Thomas Jefferson (1743-1826) Third President of the United States. Played the <u>cello</u> and <u>violin</u>.

Paula Zahn (b.1956) Newscaster and journalist. Plays the cello.

Meryl Streep (b.1949) Most Academy Award nominations for an actress. Plays the <u>violin</u>.

Charles, Prince of Wales (b. 1948) Heir to the throne of England. Plays the cello.

Tony Hawk (b. 1968) Skateboarding pioneer who plays the <u>violin</u>.

Sherlock Holmes One of literature's most famous fictional characters to play a string instrument. He owns and plays a priceless Stradivarius violin.
