All junior students with plans to attend any type of post-high school educational option (technical school, 2-year school, or college/university) are strongly encouraged to register for an ACT and/or SAT test before the end of this school year. There is only one more ACT and SAT to sign up for during this school year. Juniors who do not have at least one ACT and/or SAT completed by the end of the school year are considered "behind schedule" with the college exploration/application process. The OdysseyWare Deadline is Approaching

Any student currently enrolled in an OdysseyWare class must complete the course by May 30, 2014. This is particularly important for any seniors taking an OdysseyWare class. Remember, at the end of the school year, OdysseyWare accounts are emptied for all students. In other words, if a student does not complete a course, they will lose all of the work they have done and they will need to start over next school year.
