What should I bring?

You AND your parent/guardian should EACH bring your...

- DHS Student Username and Password for computer log in
- Your FSA ID for the student and parent (register for this at fafsa.ed.gov)
- Driver's License
- Any other income, benefit and/or tax information (Social Security, TANF benefits, veteran benefits records, current balance in cash, checking, &/or savings accounts, etc.)
- Alien Registration card (if not a U.S. citizen)
- Your Social Security Number
- Your Alien Registration Number (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- Your federal income tax returns for 2016, W-2s, and other records of money earned. (Note: You may
 be able to transfer your federal tax return information into your FAFSA using the IRS Data Retrieval
 Tool.)
