Students must complete 1500 hours of training; 1000 clock hours of training in hair, skin, and nails. The other 500 hours are given to the students for passing and completing their high school state requirements for graduation.



Upon completion of the students 1500 hours, students will take a Texas State Board Exam and Graduate with a Cosmetology Operators License.



The Cosmetology **Operators License will** allow young adults to start a professional career straight out of high school. This will allow graduates to become productive young citizens, or support themselves through college.


# In the cosmetology industry you are required to learn:
