Dear Kindergarten Families,

Our Focus

In this kindergarten science unit we will learn about the properties of matter. Students will see that matter has physical properties that can be used to classify and describe objects in their daily life. Learning about the properties of matter will help students understand how the world works.

Instructional Approach

Hands on investigations will give students experience identifying and describing the physical properties of matter such as length, mass, color, texture, and shape. Students will also use this knowledge to compare and sort objects. During our Show and Tell activity, students will select an object from home to share with classmates using our physical properties vocabulary.

Family Support

You can help your child in several ways.

- Point out and discuss the physical properties of objects around the home.
- Ask your child to show you what they learned about physical properties by describing some of their favorite things using the unit vocabulary.
- Play games such as "I Spy" and have your child find an object with the physical property you name.
