



Installing Software using SCCM (Software Center)


1. Start -> All Programs -> Software Center



2. Once the Software Center is opened you have two ways of installing the applications:
 - a. Highlight one specific application and choose the **Install** button at the bottom right-hand corner
 - b. Use the checkboxes to select multiple applications, and then choose **Install Selected** in the bottom right-hand corner



- In the bottom part of the box will be a brief overview, system requirements as well as a description of the software.
- Once the software has been installed, you will find it under the Installed Software tab.
