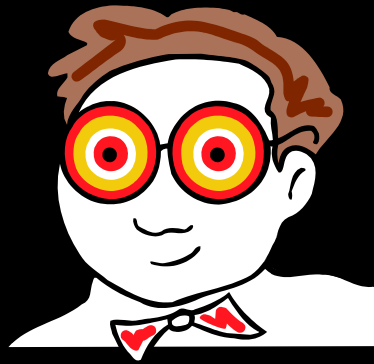

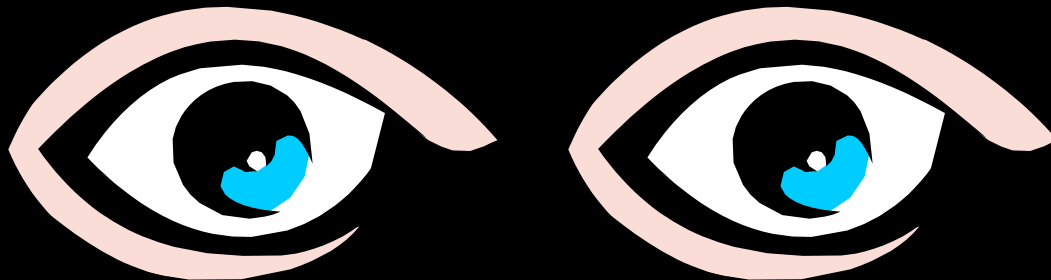
- LOTERIA is Mexican bingo, but it is played differently than American Bingo.

# HOW DO YOU PLAY?

- **EACH PERSON WILL HAVE A LOTERIA CARD AND SOME BEANS.**
- **THE CALLER WILL READ A RIDDLE OUT LOUD, AND YOU MUST FIND THE PICTURE THAT MATCHES. COVER IT WITH A BEAN.**
- **YOU MAY WIN IN TWO DIFFERENT WAYS:**
  - 1. BE THE FIRST TO COVER A LINE EITHER HORIZONTALLY, VERTICALLY, OR DIAGONALLY**
  - 2. BE THE FIRST TO COVER EVERY SQUARE**

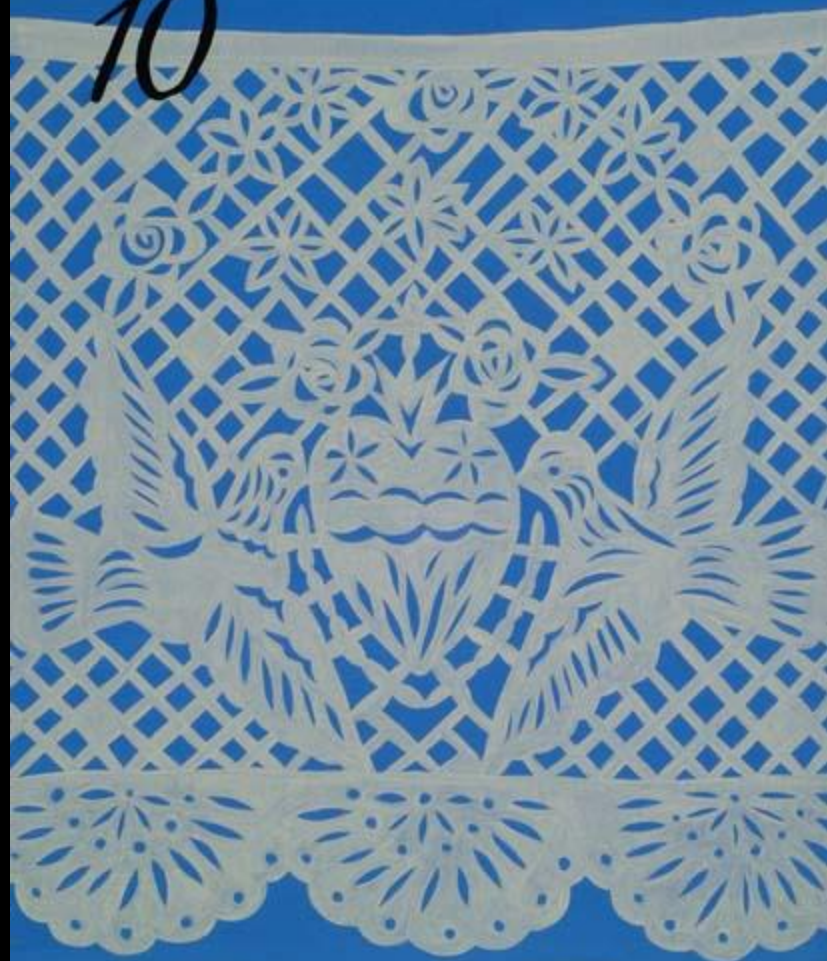
