




- LOTERIA is Mexican bingo, but it is played differently than American Bingo.
- LOTERIA is played with pictures instead of letter/number combinations.
- In the game of LOTERIA, a riddle is called out as a clue, and you must figure out the picture that goes with it to cover the space on your card.

HOW DO YOU PLAY?

- EACH PERSON WILL HAVE A LOTERIA CARD AND SOME BEANS.
- THE CALLER WILL READ A RIDDLE OUT LOUD, AND YOU MUST FIND THE PICTURE THAT MATCHES. COVER IT WITH A BEAN.
- YOU MAY WIN IN TWO DIFFERENT WAYS:
 - 1. BE THE FIRST TO COVER A LINE EITHER HORIZONTALLY, VERTICALLY, OR DIAGONALLY
 - 2. BE THE FIRST TO COVER EVERY SQUARE
- YOU MUST YELL "LOTERIA!" WHEN YOU WIN!




