Student Summer School Agreement

Some courses may require a diagnostic skills assessment that will determine the curriculum and instruction for each student. The goal of providing summer school is to not only allow students the opportunity to retrieve or advance their credits, but also to provide remediation as needed. This means that some students may receive direct instruction from the subject teacher, while others may be assigned virtual (online) instruction, or even a combination of both. For those students who are enrolled in virtual learning, the school day may look a little different. If assigned virtual learning, AND the student wishes to take his/her course online, the student and guardian must sign a contract in which they agree to abide by:

- Predetermined deadlines
- Attendance requirements
- Testing guidelines
- Daily adequate progress

Please note that enrollment in the virtual classes does NOT guarantee completion and credit. The student has the **opportunity** to move at an accelerated rate. If the student fails to complete all of the assigned work, he/she will not receive credit for the course. Therefore, it is important to note that any student who is not self-motivated to complete assignments, quizzes, and tests without direct supervision is not a student who should enroll in virtual courses.

Any student who is recommended by the summer school teacher and who wishes to participate in virtual learning can complete the coursework at Ryan High School during the normal summer school hours. However, students will have the opportunity (based on the guidelines provided on June 6, 2018) to complete some of the coursework at home. The district will not assume responsibility for a student's failure to complete a course due to technology issues (limited or no access to computers, computer is not working properly, internet is not available or working properly) or time constraints that are beyond the control of the school.

By signing this agreement, you are stating that you understand that *if* you are given the choice of virtual (online) learning, you will follow all requirements, as provided by your instructor. Failure to follow the requirements may result in removal from the virtual course and even possible removal from summer school. In addition, you understand that enrollment in the course is not a guarantee of credit earned. Ultimately you are responsible for completion and mastery of all assigned tasks.
