Benefits of the High School Advantage Program

- The Dual Credit Program is a great way to get a head start on your college education!
 - > Courses meet High School requirements, while at the same time earning college credit
 - > Courses meet Texas Common Core requirements and are fully transferable to any public college or university in Texas
 - Low cost Dual Credit courses cost less than regular college courses (\$50 per credit hour 3 hours = \$150)
 - > Convenience Texas Woman's University brings dual credit courses right to your campus!

Eligibility

- □ Meet Texas Success Initiative (TSI) requirements
- □ Maintain a "C" or higher in each dual credit course





Texas Success Initiative (TSI)

It's the Law

- TSI is a matter of state law (Texas Education Code 52.3062) and compliance is mandatory for all students who wish to attend a Texas Public institution of higher education. The law requires all entering college students to be assessed for college readiness in reading, mathematics, and writing unless the student qualifies for an exemption.
 - Pursuant to Texas Administrative Code 4.85, a high school student is eligible to enroll in dual credit courses if the student demonstrates college readiness by achieving the minimum passing standard under the provisions of the Texas Success Initiative.


