Benefits of the High School Advantage Program

 - > Courses meet Texas Common Core requirements and are fully transferable to any public college or university in Texas
 - > Low cost Dual Credit courses cost less than regular college courses (\$50 per credit hour 3 hours = \$150)

 □ Submit Official High School Transcript and Test scores


