

What is CHAMPS?

CHAMPS is the school-wide behavior system we use at Paloma Creek Elementary. CHAMPS expectations are posted in many common areas around the school, and teachers are using CHAMPS in their classrooms to clearly communicate behavior expectations to students in the following categories:

C (Conversation)

Are students allowed to talk during an activity? If so, what voice level is appropriate?

H (Help)

What procedure(s) should students use to ask for help during various school activities?

A (Activity)

What is the goal for the activity in which students are participating?

M (Movement)

For what purposes can students move during an activity? Do students need to ask for permission before moving about the room?

P (Participation)

What does good participation look like, and what does poor participation look like?

S (Success!)

If a child follows the expectations outlined in CHAMPS for each unique activity, they will be in a position to be successful at school.
