Stories from the Early Years of Rome Latin 1 project- 5th 6wks – NO LATE!!!!

The object of this project is to learn about the founding of Rome and stories from its early history. We will begin with the story of the Trojan war and Aeneas's journey and end with the over throw of the kings of Rome and the early parts of the Roman republic.

Section 1 - The Research and Sources-

1. You will have a topic to research from "the list" below. You will add your info to a <u>wiki page</u> you create for your topic.

2. You will need to have your wiki page completed for me to check by the date above.

3. Include your sources, *properly formatted* [*MLA style*], at the bottom of your wiki page. You must have at least 3 separate sources. Some of the topics have audio clips that can be used as one of your sources, but you *must* have other sources.

4. You will need to read Livy's "ab urbe condita" ["From The Founding of the City"] in translation to get the best parts of the story. Some of you can listen to the audio files, but not all stories are there. I have linked several sources on our DISD Latin page.

Section 2 – Illustration of Your Topic Presentations –

5. Your final product will be a comic strip, comic book, or movie about the story you've chosen to research. [Yes, you may put your drawings on a ppt, but it should **not** have the whole story typed out on some slides. These are ILLUSTRATIONS...that is, PICTURES. And you may NOT just use a bunch of clip art, either.]

6. There should be 5-10 pages or slides for each story, encompassing the <u>entirety</u> of the story from multiple sources. Some sources focus only on the historically provable aspects of the stories, while others include the potentially mythological aspects of the stories. While we do want the dry, provable facts, we also want the juicy bits. Include how the kings came to power and died.
7. On the due date, you will present your illustrations or movie to the class, teaching us your story from the early history of Rome.
