## Spanish I (counts as 1 high school elective credit)



This fun and interactive course is filled with diverse Spanish-language games and activities to develop beginner level proficiency in listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Students build confidence in their communication skills through the use of authentic materials (such as music videos) that aid in language acquisition. As Spanish is spoken in over 20 countries on 4 continents, students also spend time learning about the cultures and perspectives of the world's Spanish-speaking countries.

Spanish I-7 is the first half of the high school Spanish I course and is for students who would like to complete Spanish I-8 in 8th grade for a full high school elective credit towards graduation. Students who successfully complete this course are still required to complete 2 additional years of a foreign language to satisfy the high school language requirement. If students choose to continue in Spanish, they would take Spanish II in 9<sup>th</sup> grade and continue to Spanish III in 10<sup>th</sup> grade.
