

GRADUATION DAY – PARENT NEED TO KNOW

MAY 28, 2021 - 7PM @ CH COLLINS STADIUM

Everything will be outside – seating at stadium, waiting area and graduation

Live streaming will be provided for those not able to attend

Masks will be required for everyone

Clear bag policy for guests – this is the same CH Collins policy that has been for games at the stadium all year

No Tickets – please limit to 10 guests per graduate* and please use pod seating – sit with family/guests to practice social distancing

Stadium will open 1 hour before the ceremony – students will need to be there at 6pm, no later than 6:15pm

Students will know which side of stadium (Home or Visitor) they will be on before hand to help families sit on correct side

Do not bring noise makers, large balloons or decorations to graduation

More detailed information about parking and directions will be given as soon as we have more details

** If a family may have more than ten guests, we are asking that you contact our associate principal, Mr. Nedrow for accommodations.*

CEREMONY EXPECTATIONS:

Make sure that you are properly dressed for graduation. It will be outside and there will be lots of walking. No tennis shoes or flip flops. **No shorts or jeans***

Do NOT take any purses, cameras, books, multiple keys, cell phones, or anything that must be carried into the lineup area. You may bring one key or a key fob.

Do not write on or decorate your cap or gown. You will **NOT** be allowed to march with a decorated cap or gown. Carry your cap and gown into the stadium. Leave all hangers in your car.

You may have to go through a metal detector so do not take anything that you will have to leave outside.

If we take anything from you, you can retrieve those items immediately following the ceremony. If you do not claim the item, it will be available the following Tuesday, June 1, at the DHS front office.

Water will be provided for the graduates while waiting for graduation to start

*talk to your counselor or AP if this is an issue.



CLEAR BAG POLICY

All bags and personal items brought into C.H. Collins Athletic Complex and Bronco Field are subject to visual inspection.

Guests visiting C.H. Collins Athletic Complex or Bronco Field are encouraged to enter the facility carrying the fewest items possible. For guests who elect to carry additional items into the stadium, the following bag guidelines will be strictly adhered to:

Approved Bags



- Plastic storage bags
- Clear vinyl or plastic tote (mesh is not allowed)
- Small clutch (No larger than 5.5" X 8")
- Diaper bag when accompanied by an infant/young child

Prohibited Bags



Prohibited items include, but are not limited to:

- All purses, bags or containers larger than a small clutch bag
- Backpacks
- Briefcases
- Drawstring bags
- Coolers

Inspected Bags



- Camera/Video equipment bags
