
Pay attention to Mrs. Murphy's slides when entering class. They will show you the supplies needed for each day.




Respect yourself, your peers (this includes opinions and property!) and school staff & property.

### How do I reassess?

Reassessments are allowed under the following conditions:

- Review for test completed ON test day
- Original test grade is lower than a 90
- Attended at least 1 tutorial session
- All extra practice assigned is completed

Students will have 4 days after a grade is issued to complete reassessment.

### What if I am absent?
