Cell phones must remain **OUT OF SIGHT & SILENT** during class time.

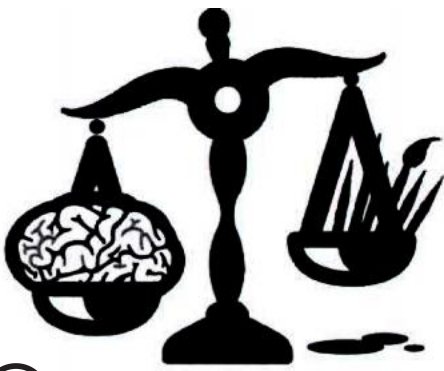
You will receive **ONE WARNING**, if your phone is seen or heard during class time. After that first warning, your phone will be checked for the remainder of class.

Quizzes or Entrance/Exit Tickets will be given on a weekly basis (or more often – dependent on the concept being taught). These minor assessments are designed to assess student learning, throughout a unit of study, and to provide students with feedback prior to a unit test.

commonly asked questions

How do I reassess?

Reassessments are allowed under the following conditions:

- Review for test completed ON test day
- Original test grade is lower than a 90
- Attended at least 1 tutorial session
- All extra practice assigned is completed

Students will have 4 days after a grade is issued to complete reassessment.

What if I am absent?

- If you are absent YOU are responsible for all missed work. Assignments/notes will be available in your classes' absent folder or on Google Classroom.
- All students will be expected to take a previously announced test on the day they return.
- A MSG will be placed in the gradebook for all missed assessments.
