Expectations of **Sociedad Honoraria Hispánica** members are drawn from the constitution and bylaws of the national **Sociedad Honoraria Hispánica**. In summary, they are:

- > Enrollment and completion of the Spanish class for which you qualify
- Attendance at the induction ceremony (March 29, 2018)
- ➤ Maintenance of 89.5% or higher in Spanish III, IV (or an 85% in AP Spanish)
- ➤ Maintenance of a minimum cumulative average of 3.5
- > Participation in **Sociedad Honoraria Hispánica** meetings and activities
- > Attendance at next year's induction ceremony of new members (unless you graduate before then)
- > Participation in the National Spanish Examination when offered
- > Maintenance of a behavior record free from suspensions, academic dishonesty, and/or a pattern of inappropriate behavior
- ➤ Meet all the deadlines and pay any required dues (currently \$20)
- > Fulfillment of the yearly service and language requirements (20 hrs per year).

Failure to meet these expectations will result in a written warning, a probation period, or removal from the **Sociedad Honoraria Hispánica**. Email will be the primary mode of communication about activities, scholarship and service opportunities.
