- Denton County is the **9th fastest growing county** in the U.S.
- 6,000 new students are expected to enroll in Denton ISD in the next 10 years.
- Denton ISD ranks 1st among DFW school districts for the most undeveloped vacant lots.
- Nearly **1,000 new home closings** were reported in the 3rd and 4th quarters of 2017.
