WHAT'S PROPOSED FOR WILSON



REPLACEMENT CAMPUS

The 2018 bond includes a proposal to build a replacement school for Wilson Elementary, which would be constructed on the same property where the current school is located.

Students would continue to attend the current campus until the new school is completed. The new campus would include a tornado shelter and additional safety features that are standard in new buildings.
