REPLACEMENT CAMPUS

The 2018 bond includes a proposal to build a replacement school for Newton Rayzor.

N. Rayzor would continue to serve as an IB elementary school and students would remain in this building until the new school is open. The new school will be constructed on or near its current location.

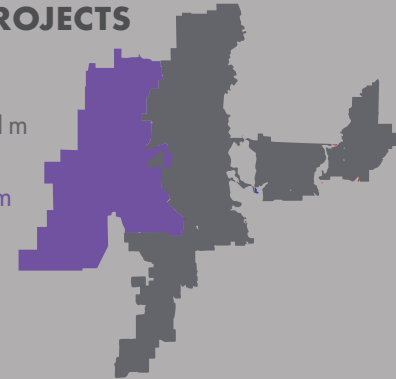
The new school would include a tornado shelter and additional safety features that are standard in new buildings.
