

## **UIL Eligibility Calendar 2025-26**

All Students meeting the UIL requirements of promotion or earned credits toward state graduation are eligible.

All Students meeting the OIL requirements of promotion or earned credits toward state graduation are eligible.
Requirements:
Jr. High – student promoted from previous grade
Sophmore – student has earned five (5) credits
Junior – student has earned ten (10) credits or five (5) credits the previous year
Senior – student has earned fifteen (15) credits or five (5) credits the previous year
Aug. 12 – Oct. 10 1st Grading Period (9 Weeks)
Oct. 15 – Dec. 19 2nd Grading Period (9 Weeks) - End of 1st Semester
Jan. 6 – March 6 3rd Grading Period (9 Weeks)
March 17 – May 22 4th Grading Period (9 Weeks) - End of 2nd Semester
Sep. 19 Mandatory eligibility check required after 6 weeks of school
Sep. 26 Students can gain or lose eligibility at the end of the school day.
Oct. 10 End of 1st Grading Period – All grades must be checked.
Oct. 17 Students can gain or lose eligibility at the end of the school day.
Oct. 31 Three-week grade checks for all ineligible students
Nov. 7 Ineligible students can gain eligibility at the end of the school day.
Nov. 21 Three-week grade checks for all ineligible students
Nov. 21 – Dec 1 All students are academically eligible to participate.
Dec. 8 Ineligible students can gain eligibility at the end of the school day.
Dec. 19 End of 2nd Grading Period – All grades must be checked.
Dec. 19 – Jan. 6 All students are academically eligible to participate.
Jan. 13 Students can gain or lose eligibility at the end of the school day.
Jan. 26 Three-week grade checks for all ineligible students
Feb. 2 Ineligible students can gain eligibility at the end of the school day
Feb. 13 Three-week grade checks for all ineligible students
Feb. 20 Ineligible students can gain eligibility at the end of the school day.
Mar. 6 End of 3rd Grading Period – All grades must be checked.
Mar. 6– Mar. 17 All students are academically eligible to participate.
Mar. 24 Students can gain or lose eligibility at the end of the school day.  *April 7 Three week grade checks for all inclining the students.
*April 7 Three-week grade checks for all ineligible students  *April 14 Ineligible students can gain eligibility at the earlief the school day.
*April 14 Ineligible students can gain eligibility at the end of the school day
April 24 Three-week grade checks for all ineligible students
May 1 Ineligible students can gain eligibility at the end of the school day.
May 22 End of 4th Grading Period

<sup>\*</sup> Three week grade check is on 4/7 if not in school on 4/3 and 4/6. If not in school on 4/3 but in school on 4/6 then the three week grade check would be on 4/6.

If not in school on 4/3 but in school on 4/6 ineligible students can gain eligibility at the end of the school day 4/13

Students with the correct number of credits will be eligible when school begins in the fall.
