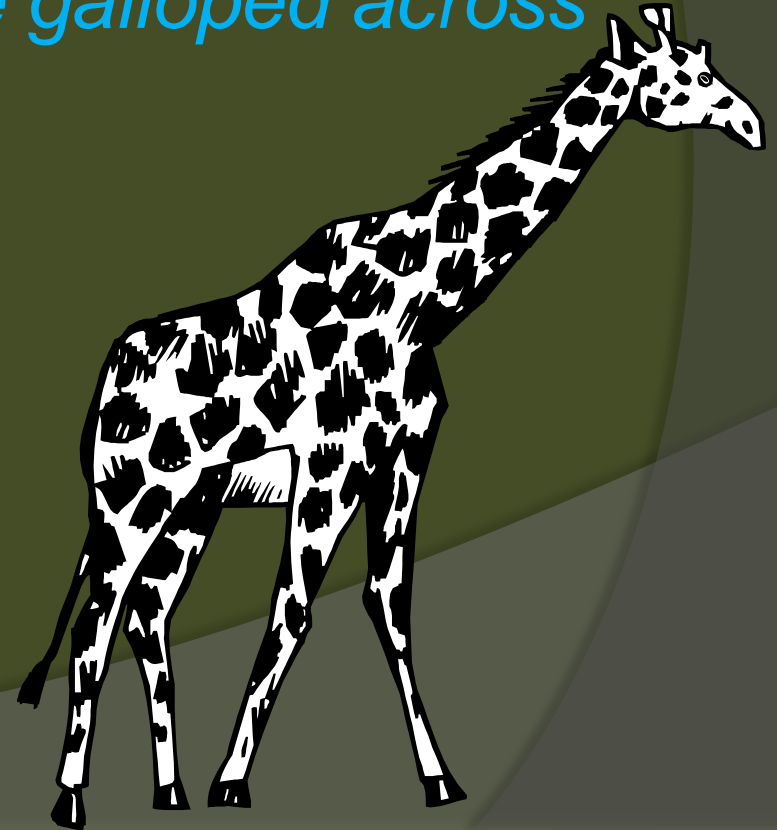
obstacle

- ◉ Verb
- ◉ To turn or wind; wander

wrath

- ◎ Noun
- ◎ Great anger; rage; fury
- ◎ *The angry buffalo charged toward me with wrath.*



dilly-dally

- ⦿ Verb
- ⦿ To waste time; dawdle; lolly-gag, procrastinate
- ⦿ *Sometimes I dilly-dally so that I can stop and smell the flowers on my way to the park.*



accelerate

- ◉ Verb – action word
- ◉ To increase speed; to speed up

- ◎ Verb
- ◎ To overcome or win
- ◎ *I persevered to triumph over my adversaries and win Excalibur.*

- ⦿ Adjective
- ⦿ Very bright, shining
- ⦿ *Charlotte thought that Wilbur was radiant, and amazed everyone by writing the word in her web.*
