acquired

- Verb – action word
- To obtain as one's own, to get
- *The merchant acquired more provisions to sell in his pet shop.*



transported

- Verb – action word
- Taken or carried from one place to another
- *Marcus and his friends were transported across the ocean on the good ship Lollipop.*



detected

- Verb – action word
- To discover or catch something in the performance of some act
- *Mrs. Spoor's feral cat detected the scent of a mouse.*



abundant

- adjective – describing word
- 1. present in great quantity; 2. well supplied
- *Researchers found an abundant supply of interesting fish in the ocean.*



essential

- adjective – describing word
- 1. absolutely necessary, very important
- *Water is an essential provision to transport into the Sahara Desert.*



joyous

- Adjective – describing word for nouns
- joyful; happy; jubilant
- *The joyous sounds of children playing drowned out the cacophony of the migrating geese.*



drenched

- Verb
- To soak: to wet thoroughly
- *After running for 7 hours in the hot sun, I was drenched with sweat.*
- *The sprinkler drenches our yard every week.*



constructed

- Verb
- To build- past tense of construct
- To put together
- *They constructed the Empire State Building in New-York city.*
- Martin Luther King, Jr. constructed an entire new world of peace!



astonished

- Verb
- Past tense of astonish
- To surprise; to fill with sudden and overpowering surprise or wonder; to amaze
- *American people were astonished when Martin Luther King, Jr. was assassinated.*



frigid

- Adjective – describing word for nouns
- not scorching, very cold
- *The air can turn frigid when a Nor'easter blows into Boston.*
