The report provides information concerning student performance on the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR), as well as information on student enrollment, class size averages, and financial expenditures. As you review the report card, please make note of the following information:

SCHOOL ACCOUNTABILITY RATING: In 2016, McNair Elementary earned a Met Standard rating from the state of Texas for excellence in academic achievement. This rating was earned because of the hard work of our teachers and students and is based on four performance measures that are identified in the Performance Index section on the school report card.

PERFORMANCE INDEX: Our campus exceeded the target score in all four of the performance indexes.

DISTINCTION DESIGNATIONS: These are awarded in recognition of outstanding student achievement in specific categories. In 2016 our campus was recognized for ELA/Reading, Mathematics, Science, Postsecondary Readiness and Top 25% Closing Performance Gaps.
