


Common Worries

- Do NOT share your combination or your locker with ANYONE!
- Cover your lock when you are putting in your combination.
- Keep your locker closed and locked when you're not getting something out or putting something in. Keep your stuff SAFE!

Attendance




- •In middle school, all absent notes go to the Attendance Clerk's office which is located at the front of the office.

 Notes no longer go to the teachers.
- •You are now <u>responsible</u> for getting your notes turned into the Attendance Office.
- •Notes have to be turned in within 72 hours, or three days, after the absence or it will be considered unexcused.
- •When you have 3 unexcused absences within a 4 week period, you will be sent a warning letter.
