## **Denton ISD Career and Technical Education Recommended Sequences**

Denton Independent School District offers all sixteen Federal Career Clusters for our students' career planning. With so many options students must plan carefully to enhance their skill portfolio. In addition to the state graduation requirements students are encouraged to select a career cluster and program of study. It is vital to understand that many opportunities are available through Career and Technical Education (CTE); they provide an "added value" beyond the high school diploma. For instance, currently there are options in CTE for students to earn college credits free of charge with the statewide articulation process. Industry credentials such as earning certification and licensures will increase employability skills. In order to receive the optimum skill development a student would follow the four year programs of study listed below. However, realistically this may be impossible and the student will need to start at an advanced level. Most classes have no prerequisites so students can enter the pathway at any time. However, students need to take classes that complement their career goal. Since computer skills are essential for both "College and Career Readiness" we recommend that all students take Business Information Management I (BIM).
