Student Parking

Student parking will be on the east side of the new portion of the building or in the CH Collins Athletic Complex parking lot. Please note, students are not allowed to park in Visitor Parking or in the Staff Parking. Parking violations can include: warning stickers, citations, wheel boots, fines, and towing.

Parking permits can be purchased at the front office for \$15. (cash or check only) Complete the parking permit request form <u>here</u>.

Parents are responsible for transporting students to and/or from school if they miss the bus. Transportation will NOT return to pick up students who miss the bus

Door Security

Do not prop outside doors open for any reason. All doors should be closed and secured for everyone's safety. Do not let friends or anyone else in the building through side doors. All students and visitors should enter through the front entrance.

All students arriving outside the normal arrival times as well as visitors, must utilize the new audio/video door buzz-in system. The buzz-in device is at the front of the building, at the far left glass door. After ringing the bell, listen for the receptionist, following prompts as necessary.

- The LaGrone Academy follows the DISD dress code guidelines.
- Additional dress code guidelines will be given and enforced based on specific industry standards as related to the coursework.

Student Absences

Please remember that any student who is out for five consecutive days must have a doctor's excuse to excuse the absences. Texas attendance rules say that a student has to be in a class at least 90% of the time if they want to be sure to get credit for that class. Students who are absent (excused or unexcused) for more than 10% of the class, will lose credit based on attendance. These students must make up the lost hours in order to regain credit for the course.

All parent notes should be submitted within 3 days of the student's return from being absent. If there are excessive absences, students will be placed on medical note only. School absence notes can be uploaded <u>HERE</u>. You can also upload using this QR Code.



Student Tardies

Students must be on-time and present for classes. Students are allotted 3 free tardies per semester. Students will receive consequences for anything after 3 tardies.

Technology Usage and Expectations

Denton ISD is a one to one district. All students receive a Chromebook. Chromebooks must be returned upon graduation or if a decision is made to leave the district. Graduates will be offered the opportunity to purchase their Chromebook in May! If you do not have a Denton ISD Chromebook, let the front office know so that we can help you!

Here are some expectations regarding technology while enrolled at the LaGrone Academy:

- 1) Bring your ChromeBook fully charged with its charger EVERYDAY!
 - a. If you damage your ChromeBook, you will be assessed a fee for the repair or replacement.
 - b. It is highly recommended that you purchase the district insurance for your device.
- 2) Utilize technology for educational purposes. It should not be a distraction to you or anyone around you.
- 3) Any student failing to return an item in acceptable condition loses the right to free textbooks and technology until the item is returned or the damage paid for by the parent; however, the student will be provided the necessary alternative instructional resources and equipment for use at school during the school day.
- 4) Cell phones should remain turned off during the instructional day, including during all testing, unless they are being used for approved instructional purposes.
- 5) Students are prohibited from possessing, sending, forwarding, posting, accessing, or displaying electronic messages that are abusive, obscene, sexually oriented, threatening, harassing, damaging to another's reputation, or illegal.

<u>Lion Laws</u>

- Students are NOT allowed in the staff areas. The staff lounge, staff offices, and staff restrooms are off limits to students.
- Students with 1st or 4th block off, cannot stay on campus. The bus will NOT transport students during this time. If you do not regularly have a

ride, you will be assigned to another class to complete your schedule.

- Students are NOT allowed in classrooms without supervision
- Students should NOT visit other classrooms during break-time.
 - Please stay in your designated area. Do not cross the Star unless you are going to the bistro.
- DO be present in mind and body.
- Participate in YOUR learning.
- Encourage others.
- Communicate with teachers.
- Have FUN!

Consequences for Unsatisfactory Behavior
