

What do I need to bring to registration?

If you are enrolling in an Denton Adult Education class, You need to bring:

- Photo ID
- Social Security card (if applicable)

Other Acceptable forms of ID

- Birth certificate
- Official record showing date of birth
- Baptismal record
- DD-214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty
- Driver's license
- Federal, state, or local government identification card
- Hospital record of birth
- Passport
- Public assistance/social service records
- School records
- School identification card
- Work permit
- Native American tribal document
- Other official documents issued by a federal, state, or local government agency, such as discharge documents from the Texas Department of Criminal Justice, with date of birth included, or a voter registration card or certificate.
- Other official documents issued by a foreign government agency, such as a consular identification card

If you are 18 or younger, You also need to bring,

16 years of age

- Court order

17 years of age

- Attestation that student is not currently enrolled in school
- Any of the following:
 - Parent permission (on enrollment form)
 - Court order
 - Proof and/or attestation that 17-year-old lives separate from parent/guardian
 - Proof and/or attestation of homelessness

18 years of age

- Attestation that student is not currently enrolled in school
- Any of the following:
 - Parent permission (on enrollment form)
 - Court order
 - Proof and/or attestation that 18-year-old lives separate from parent/guardian
 - Proof and/or attestation of homelessness
