BASIC PROFILE FOR ALL DENTON ISD LIBRARIES:

- Denton ISD has one central cataloger and one processing profile. All specifications outlined in this document apply to all schools in Denton ISD, except where individual campuses may choose an option (highlighted in yellow throughout this document). Individual campuses or librarians cannot make or request changes to the district processing specs. If there are questions about the requirements outlined in this document, please email library@dentonisd.org or call 940-369-0149.
- Please provide separate digital cataloging files by resource type, i.e., separate files for print books, eBooks, eAudiobooks, makerspace items, and other library materials.
- Cataloged records must follow current established standards in the library science/cataloging field, including proper use of diacritics when appropriate, as well as Library of Congress authorities for series (800 or 830 tags, as appropriate) and other authority-controlled fields.
- Please provide MARC21 records (latest version) *with barcodes* (see below for additional barcode/barcode range info).
- Records must conform to original RDA standards as well as 949 holdings tag format (detailed below). RDA is strongly preferred, but we can still accept AACR2.
- Classification: Unabridged Dewey, latest edition (see further instructions below).
- Subject Headings must be Library of Congress. DO NOT include Sears Subject Headings in MARC records.
- Convert the form subdivision \$vJuvenile fiction to \$vFiction. Do not use subdivision \$vJuvenile literature.
- Include a 520 tag summary.
- Please strip 856 tags that contain book cover image links.

BARCODES & BARCODE RANGE INFORMATION:

- Barcodes must be imprinted with 'Denton ISD'.
- Barcode ranges are centrally controlled by Denton ISD Library Services. Please request needed barcode ranges by email to library@dentonisd.org. Please include the PO number and the number of barcodes needed in email request.
- Barcode label symbology: 14-digit CODABAR (Mod 10) with check digit.

DATA ON ELECTRONIC RECORDS:

- Provide 13-digit ISBN. If 13-digit is not available, provide 10-digit but NOT both.
- Provide all notes and bibliography, contents, annotation (or review), and index.
- Provide all added entries.
- Provide dates from personal name subject headings.
- Provide dates from personal name added entries.
- Audience/Readability/Level and review sources – tag 521:
 1. Remove 521 with indicator 1 (interest age level).
 2. For 521 indicator 0, insert Reading grade level: <space> at the beginning of the subfield a.
 - Example: 521_0 \$aReading grade level: _2.8.
 3. For 521 indicator 2, insert *Interest grade level:* <space> at the beginning of the subfield a.
 - Example: 521_2 \$aInterest grade level: _K-3.
 4. Remove Lexile level measures.
 5. End subfield a in a period. Do NOT include subfield b (source) for either Reading grade level or Interest grade level.
- Place holdings in formation in 949 tag.
- Provide multiple copy barcode numbers in separate 949 tags.

MARC21 RECORDS:

- System interface is Library.Solution (The Library Corporation, Version 5.7.3).
- Records must be formatted to current MARC21 bibliographic standards.
- Provide one record per title using MARC21, not one record per copy or volume.
- Format holdings records according to current MARC21 holdings standards with UTF-8 Unicode.
- Please provide records via electronic download or electronic file delivery.

NONFICTION:

- Unabridged Dewey cut at first prime with a preferred maximum of 2 digits past the decimal, however up to 4 digits may be used where proper Dewey subjects require 4 decimal places.
- Cutter for the first three letters of the author's last name in ALL CAPS.
- Any available volume information is to be included in the 949 subfield i of the MARC record, but do not include this information on the printed spine label.
- Classify individual biography books as B with the first three letters of the biographeé as the cutter in ALL CAPS.
- Classify collective biography as 920, cuttered with the first three letters of the author's last name (or title if title is the main entry) in ALL CAPS.
- Classify reference material REF above the Dewey classification number.
- Spanish language materials: Add the letter designation SP above the Dewey classification number.
- Other foreign language materials: For all campuses except IB Schools (their specs to follow) classify with appropriate Dewey classification (ex: 448.6 – French).
 - * **For our four (4) IB schools**-Denton High, Calhoun Middle, Borman Elementary, & Newton Rayzor Elementary, any foreign language material other than Spanish will go into a separate World Languages collection with the prefix WL in front of the standard call number for FIC, E, Dewey number, B (biography) with the holdings information using branch number + WL as the holdings code in the 949\$a (ex: Denton HS would be 949\$a003WL).
- **Graphic novels**-the district default is for all graphic novels to be classified in Nonfiction as either 741.5 or subject content Dewey, however, campuses do have the option to choose to genrefy their Fiction collections and we do allow an option for these campuses to include their Fiction graphic novels as a Fiction genre, GRA (see more specifics regarding genres to follow).

FICTION:

- Fiction classification is FIC with the first three letters of the author's last name in ALL CAPS.
- Easy fiction and picture books are classified as E with the first three letters of the author's last name in ALL CAPS.
- Story collection books are classified as SC with the first three letters of the author's last name or first three letters of the title (if main entry) in ALL CAPS.
 - * **NOTE**: Braswell HS, Denton HS, Guyer HS, and Ryan HS do not use Story Collection and many of our schools are beginning to phase this collection out. For schools that do not have a Story Collection, include these items with Fiction.
- Include any available volume information in the 949 subfield i of the MARC record, but do not include on the printed spine label.
- * **We do allow some campuses to choose genre processing for Fiction** (see information & table to follow for schools and for genre processing requirements)

AUDIOVISUAL MATERIALS:

- Classify appropriately as fiction or nonfiction according to Dewey, cuttered with the first three letters of the title entry.
- Classify individual biography (B) cuttered with the first three letters of the biographeé's last name.

EBOOKS:

- eBook classification/call number is EBOOK with the remaining portion for the respective collection or Dewey, (ex: EBOOK FIC or EBOOK 398.2).
- Holdings code for all online materials and eBooks is URL (see holdings code chart).

GRAPHIC NOVELS:

- **Graphic Novel Option** – Even though our district default is for all graphic novels to be classified in Nonfiction 741.5 or Dewey subject content, most of our schools do exercise the option to have Fiction genre shelving and use the genre abbreviation 'GRA' for fiction graphic novels.
- 'GRA' should NOT be added to graphic novels that are cataloged as Nonfiction.
- The district preference is to catalog Nonfiction graphic novels with the appropriate Dewey number (subject content) or as 741.5, but either is acceptable and is at the campus librarian's discretion.

GENRE PROCESSING OPTION – FICTION ONLY (*specified campuses*):

- All schools listed in the chart below will need genre processing for Fiction.
- Books will need a genre sticker placed directly above the spine label.
- MARC records will need to have the genre subject heading added (if not already present).
- A genre abbreviation will be added to the MARC 949 subfield d. Labels, genre abbreviation, and genre subject heading are according to the chart to follow.
- **Graphic Novel Option** – even though our district default is for all graphic novels to be classified in Nonfiction 741.5, over the years most of our schools have opted to exercise the option to have fiction genre shelving and use the genre abbreviation ‘GRA’ for graphic novels in fiction. ‘GRA’ should NOT be added when graphic novels are cataloged as nonfiction (see chart for elementary and secondary fiction genres).
 - * *Nonfiction* graphic novels should be cataloged as Dewey subject content or as 741.5 (campus discretion).
- Genre Stickers – Elementary genre stickers are standardized and shown in the chart to follow. Check with Secondary Librarians for preferred sticker when processing genre fiction. Genre sticker placement should be directly above the spine label with call number.

PHYSICAL ITEM PROCESSING REQUIREMENTS

BARCODES & BARCODE RANGE INFORMATION

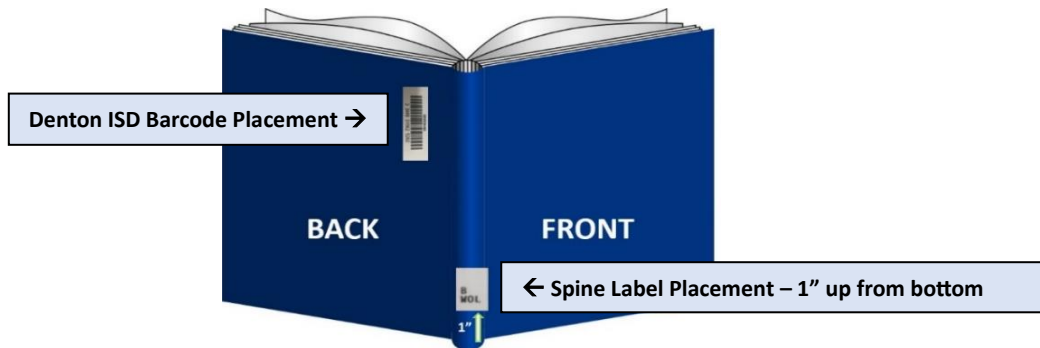
- Barcodes for all locations are to be imprinted with 'Denton ISD'.
- Barcodes numbers are centrally controlled by Denton ISD Library Services. Vendors must request barcode range at by email at: library@dentonisd.org. Please include the quantity and PO number for which the barcodes needed in the request.
- Barcode label symbology: 14-digit CODABAR (Mod 10) with check digit
- Print Item barcode placement: Back, upper right, vertical (see diagram).

PHYSICAL LABELS REQUIRED & PLACEMENT ON BOOKS:

- One (1) Denton ISD barcode label affixed as shown below covered with 2.5-mil clear label protector.
- One (1) spine label with call number, affixed one inch (1") from the bottom of the book spine edge to the dust cover or to book itself (if there is no dust cover) covered with 2.5-mil clear spine label protector.
- One (1) school address/location address property label attached to bottom 1/3 of title page but placed so that label does not cover publisher imprint or cataloging information. It is ok to move left/right, up/down, as long as property label is located in the bottom third of the title page.

COVERING BOOKS:

- Attach Mylar jackets to all hardback books with dust covers—taped, not glued.
- All paperback books should be covered with clear laminate or clear Kapco, unless otherwise specified by the campus.



PHYSICAL LABELS REQUIRED FOR AUDIOVISUAL MATERIALS:

- Provide, but do not affix one (1) Denton ISD barcode label & 2.5-mil clear label protector.
- Provide, but do not affix one (1) spine label with call number & 2.5-mil clear spine label protector.
- Provide, but do not affix one (1) school address/location address property label.
