- 5.13 <u>Franklin D. Roosevelt</u> Wins the Presidency in 1932. He campaigns on his ideas about the federal govt. giving direct aide to people suffering during the depression. His ideas are called "The New Deal."
- 5.14 <u>Huey Long</u> Was an opponent to FDR and the New Deal, he advocated high taxes on the wealthy and to redistribute the wealth to the poor.
- 5.15 <u>Father Charles Coughlin</u> Was an opponent of The New Deal, he called it the "Raw Deal". He called for the Nationalization of Industry. He was also anti-Semitic (against Jews). He was forced by the church to end his broadcast.
- 5.16 **Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC)** Was organized to regulate the stock market, and is still with us today.
- 5.17 Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) Guaranteed bank deposits.
- 5.18 **Social Security Administration** created an income for the elderly, unemployment insurance, and other benefits to help workers.

6.0 World War II

- 6.1 <u>Adolf Hitler</u> Became the dictator of Germany and lead the German people to aggressively invade the most of Europe.
- 6.2 Benito Mussolini Became the dictator of Italy and allied themselves with Hitler and Germany
- 6.3 <u>Hideki Tojo</u> Military dictator of Japan and allied Japan with Hitler and Germany, while violently invading China, Korea, and the islands of the South Pacific.
- 6.4 <u>World War II</u> Begins when Germany invades Poland and England declares war on Germany. Germany then invades and takes over most of Europe.
- 6.5 <u>US entry into WWII</u> Japan carries out a sneak attack on Pearl Harbor, this the US Navel base in the Pacific. The next day 12/07/41 FDR ask Congress for a Declaration or War on Japan. Germany then declares war on the US.
- 6.6 <u>Franklin D. Roosevelt</u> Is the President of the US throughout most of WWII. He forges strong alliances with England' Winston Churchill, and The USSR's Joseph Stalin. FDR is able to inspire American industry to produce levels of war material that gives the US the edge it needs to win the war.
- 6.7 <u>Harry Truman</u> Becomes President in April of 1945, he makes the decision to use nuclear weapons in August of 1945, and the war is over with in a few days.
- 6.8 The Office of War Information (OWI) Through radio, newspaper, posters, photographs, and films. The OWI was the connection between the Homefront and the battlefront.
