




# Meet the Kindergarten Team! Ms. Denton


Ms. Ice

In kindergarten, your child will build the foundational skills for reading such as:

- ★ Developing concepts of print, phonemic awareness, and phonics.
- ★ Learning reading strategies that help them search for meaning, use picture clues, work on fluency, and communicate meaning.
- ★ Becoming independent and using reading strategies to read with more accuracy, fluency, and comprehension.







In writing, your child will gain skills such as:

- $\star$  Labeling their drawings
- $\star$  Writing stories
- ★ Creating how-to books
- $\star$  Crafting persuasive letters





## Helpful Tips to Prepare for kindergarten

- ★ Count with your child in the car: take turns having your child say the next number where you leave off: 1, 2, 3, 4, \_ , 6, 7, \_ , 9, 10, 11...)
- $\star$  Sing lots of rhyming Preschool songs with your child.
- ★ Read to your child at least 15 minutes each day. (Help them identify the cover, how we turn pages, etc.)
- ★ Talk about beginning sounds of words: "Mama begins with MMMM."
- $\star$  Have your child trace his/her name.





## Helpful Tips to Prepare for kindergarten

- ★ Have you'r child trace his/her name.
- ★ Talk with your child and encourage full sentences when appropriate. Instead of "Cookie," require that your child says, "I would like a cookie, please." Instead of "car," encourage him/her to say, "I see a white car driving really fast!"
- ★ Let them run, jump, spin, swing, and explore how their bodies move in space.
- ★ Let them sleep for at least 11 hours each night. (7:30 PM- 6:30 AM)





#### Skills We Hope to See in August

★ Can write his/her name  $\star$  Can count to 30  $\star$  Can count up to 10 objects, pointing to them one at a time  $\star$  Can say the alphabet  $\star$  Knows colors ★ Can take turns  $\star$  Can draw a picture of him/herself  $\star$  Can rhyme words (cat, sat, bat)



#### **Dismissal Procedures**

- All car riders must have a visible car tag. Families with multiple children will be dismissed from the youngest child's dismissal location.
- ★ All Kinder-Fifth grade students will be dismissed using the front car line.
- All PK students and students in special programs will be dismissed using the bus line located on the side of the building.
- ★ Students will be dismissed using the same path as arrival.







Arrival & Dismissal



#### **BIG IDEAS**

- ★ Do what you're directed to do. It may not make sense to you at first, but\'we know what we are doing and when everyone follows the procedures arrival and dismissal is safe and very efficient.
- ★ It will go faster if you do what we ask you to do, even if it does not make sense.
- ★ It will take a loooooog time on the first day and possibly the first two weeks.
- $\star$  By the third week of school or so:
  - Arrival will likely not have much of a line or you will wait in the line fewer than 5 minutes.
  - Dismissal will take 20 minutes or less, from start to finish,









## Student safety is a priority at Hodge Elementary.

All visitors must check in at the front office and show appropriate identification.

According to district policy, parents are not able to walk students to class after the first full week of school in order to keep ALL students safe.


Please only send food your child can open and eat independently.

SchoolCafé is the online portal to handle school lunch and breakfast payment options,menus and online benefits application.



To submit an absence note, you may -



Student Health Information



### Student Health is a priority at Hodge Elementary.

- ★ Stay home from school for 24 hours after fever over 99.9.°F, vomiting, or diarrhea have stopped without medicine.
- ★ Bring Doctors' notes to the front office when your child returns to school.
- ★ Keep us updated on current parent & emergency contact numbers.
- ★ Keep your child supplied with extra clothes and underwear in case of accidents or playground mishaps. (Reminder: change out extra clothing for appropriate season)





### Student Health Information



Denton ISD protocol states that students with the conditions listed below should not come to school. If the student becomes ill at school with these same symptoms, they will be sent home:

- ★ Fever over 99.9°F. Must be symptom free for 24 hours (without meds) before returning to school and must see the nurse before returning to class.
- ★ Vomiting and/or Diarrhea

★ Pink Eye (Red crusty eyes with discharge & matting)









## Immunizations

- ★ Your child must be up to date on immunizations to start and stay in school.

- ★ If you have any questions or concerns please visit with nurse.

## Medications

- ★ DISD does not supply any medication including pain relief meds, antibiotic ointment, anti itch cream, cough drops, etc.
- ★ You may supply school medications for your child per DISD protocol.
- ★ Never put medication in your child's possession. This could endanger not only your child but also the children surrounding him/her.




## Medications

 $\star$  ALL medications (over the counter and prescription):

- Must be given to the nurse to dispense.
- Must be original container
- Must be supplied by parent.
- Must not be expired.

★ For prescription meds: Must have a doctor order on label from pharmacy.













## Medications

 $\star$  Please note that even cough drops can be dangerous!

★ A child who has a cough drop in their mouth can fall or get bumped resulting in airway obstruction and not being able to breathe.

Cough drops also need physician order and the school nurse must dispense them.

## Asthma

#### Let the Nurse Know If:

- ★ Your child needs routine inhalation medications before PE or recess.
- $\star$  If your child receives nebulizer treatments.
- ★ If your child has an asthma action plan, please give nurse a copy.

## Allergies

#### LIFE THREATENING ALLERGIES:

Nurse needs to:

- $\star$  Know what student is allergic to.
- $\star$  Know if student uses an Epipen or Benadryl.
- $\star$  Have medication on campus ASAP.

#### FOOD ALLERGIES:

If there is a true food allergy, you will need to:


- $\star$  Notify the nurse and complete a dietary form with the pediatrician.
- ★ Notify nurse of true food allergies such as nut products or dairy foods.
- ★ Consult with the school nurse and the cafeteria manager to discuss your child's food allergy needs.

#### At Hodge, bilingualism, biliteracy, and biculturalism is important.

Students who fully participate in our two way dual language program will be able to:

- ★ Learn in two languages: English & Spanish
- ★ Respect and value people who come from cultures or background experiences different from their own.
- ★ Listen, speak, read, and write in both languages after 5-6 years. (They will likely not be balanced bilinguals, yet.)
- ★ Prepared to enter the two-way dual language program at their feeder middle schools and high schools so that they can graduate with a seal of bilingual proficiency.


