LEARN-TO-SWIM SWIM LESSONS

Water Tots, ages 6 months to 3 years

Parent and child aquatics builds ability through games and songs. Ratio is 10:1.

Preschool, ages 3-4

A great intro to the water. Kids learn floating, kicking, bubble blowing, and safety. Ratio is 5:1.

Level 1: Intro to Water, ages 5+

This builds from beginner skills through the introduction of different strokes. Ratio is 6:1.

Level 2: Fundamental Skills, ages 5+

This teaches alternating arm action, rhythmic bobbing, glides, and safety. Ratio is 6:1.

Level 3: Stroke Development, ages 6+

Students learn rotary breathing, dolphin kick, backstroke, safety, and more. Class ratio is 6:1.

Level 4: Stroke Development, ages 6+

This level focuses on endurance and refines strokes while adding new ones, like butterfly, backstroke, breaststroke, and more. Ratio is 6:1.
