


# Connecting non-district laptops to disd wireless


- Click the Start button and click Control Panel






- Click the 'Security' tab.




- Click 'Settings'.




- Uncheck the “Validate server certificate” box.




- Click 'Configure'.




- Uncheck the box.




- Click 'OK'.

- Click "Advanced settings."




- Check the box for "Specify authentication mode."
