5. Respect for ownership — Only district software will be used on all DISD computers. All software installed on any school computer must be for educational use and legally owned by the District. All Software must be installed by a Denton ISD Technology member!
6. Respect For others and the Law — All activities are to be within the law. Activities are to be beneficial to others. We expect you to follow copyright © laws and to respect all copyright issues regarding software © information attributes of authorship.

Consequences

Above you will find the district rules and expectations for computer use at Guyer High School. We would like for you to remember that access to the system is a privilege and that we expect you to follow all of the rules. If you break any of the rules you will lose your privileges.

1. The First violation (depending on what it is) will get you removed for a period of time.
2. The Second violation (depending on what it is) will also get you removed for a period of time.
3. The Third violation will get you Permanently Removed.
 - a. Removed and Permanently Removed means – that you will not be able to log into ANY computer in our building. Your teachers and parents will be notified of any violations.
