After students having finished reading a chapter or portion of a book, an excerpt from a book, a short story, etc., they can journal information concerning the characters, themes, conflict, and setting. Additional objectives can be added for students to include in their journal such as main idea, summary, etc

When the teacher assigned reading is completed, students should open an Inspiration template. In Inspiration 7.6 go to File > Open Templates > Language Arts > Literary Web

The main idea of the story can be added as a "Note" on the Story Title



To add another branch off of the main idea, click on the main idea, click Create, type the name of the new branch and choose a symbol (picture) from the symbol palette (if the palette is not visible on the screen click f8)
