

## Six Flags FAQs (Frequently Asked Questions)

### 1. How do I know if I am eligible to go?

Students MUST meet the following criteria in order to be eligible to attend the Six Flags trip:

- Pass **ALL** classes on 5<sup>th</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> weeks report card.
- Maintain passing grades until the day of the trip. You will not be able to attend if you are failing any classes!!!!!! MAKE GOOD DECISIONS!
- **NO ISLC** assignments January 8, 2013- June 3, 2013
- **CHOIR DUES** must be paid in FULL!!!! (\$50) Tickets will not be ordered unless dues have been paid.
- **ALL** fund-raiser money turned in
- Attend the Spring Concert on Tuesday, May 7, 2013 and have EXCELLENT behavior while in attendance
- Have satisfactory behavior in **ALL** classes

### 2. When do we go & how much does it cost?

Thursday, May 30<sup>th</sup>. We will leave at 9:00 a.m. BE ON TIME TO SCHOOL!!!  
Cost is \$50 per person. If you have a Season Pass, your cost is \$25. Chaperone tickets are \$30 each (if you ride the bus.) If you decide to drive your car, please know that parking is \$15-20. **The deadline for turning in your money for the trip is Friday, May 3rd. NO EXCEPTIONS ☺** This date is set by Six Flags. Remember, refunds will not be given for students who become ineligible, are absent, suspended or sick on the day of the trip!!!!

### 3. What can we wear?

You are allowed to wear DISTRICT DRESS CODE. You MUST comply with the district's dress code regarding length of your shorts and appropriate t-shirts. You may wear your swimsuit (**one piece**) underneath your t-shirt. Wear comfortable shoes – **NO flip flops or loose sandals**. If you are not wearing your swimsuit underneath your t-shirt and plan on riding the water rides, **DO NOT** wear a white t-shirt!

### 4. Can we bring cell phones, cameras, iPods, etc?

You may bring these items. \*\*\*\*\*HOWEVER, CMS will not be held responsible for lost items. It is the responsibility of the student to keep up with their belongings at all times. Lockers are available for an additional fee at Six Flags.

### 5. Am I able to change clothes? No.

### 6. Can we bring food?

No, as you will not be allowed to take food into Six Flags. This means you need to bring money to buy food there.

7. Do we need to buy a ticket?

No. The \$50 you paid your teacher covers your ticket and bus fee. You will need to bring your own spending money.

8. Do we get to pick the people in our group?

There are two options for groups:

-Students must stay in groups of at least 3 students at all times.

OR -Students will be placed in a group with a chaperone (5 students or less)

Students will have as much choice **as possible** as to the members of their group. Group members can be chosen from another class but must be approved. Your teacher will have the final say in your group assignment.

Student groups will be required to check-in at 10:30, 2:00, and 6:00. Any student failing to check in at the designated time, or any student who leaves their group will be made to stay at the checkpoint with one of the chaperones for the rest of the trip. **YOU are responsible for keeping track of time. A CMS parent or teacher will be at the front fountain/gate all day long. If you have an emergency or need to get in contact with me, find the parent or teacher wearing the orange CMS name badge!!!!**

9. When do we get back?

Six Flags closes at 6:00 pm. We will arrive back at Calhoun around 7:30 pm. Your parent needs to be WAITING at Calhoun to pick you up.

10. Will the park be closed just for us? No.

11. Is romance allowed?

NO!!!!!!!!!! You must follow **ALL** District and Calhoun Student Code of Conduct Rules while on this trip. Students breaking these rules will be required to stay with a chaperone at the check-in point all day OR, for major problems will be sent home. If a student is causing major problems the parent will be required to come and pick their child up from Six Flags immediately.

12. What happens to my ticket if I am failing a class or absent on the day of the trip, get ISLC, or am unable to attend the choir concert?

Six Flags does not refund any money for unused tickets, therefore; I will be unable to refund any of your money. Plan ahead, make good choices, and keep up with your assignments!!
