### DENTON ISD RECOMMENDED DAEP REFERRAL DURATIONS

This document is designed to assist school officials in determining disciplinary responses to the most <u>common offenses committed</u> both on and off campus. The document is based on the requirements of Texas Education Code Chapter 37, the Chapter 37 chart produced by TASB, and the Board-approved Student Code of Conduct. It includes PEIMS Reason and Action Codes. The rules concerning student conduct apply to actions of students on school property, school buses, designated bus stops, and, in some cases, for non-school related offenses and actions of students at all school-sponsored or school-related activities or events, such as field trips, sporting events, stadium assemblies, and fairs.

A DAEP Placement should be utilized as a last resort. Unless the infraction warrants a mandatory placement, various alternative consequences must have taken place to address the behavior before DAEP is considered. If a student is being placed for multiple infractions, the behavioral MTSS process is a prerequisite for discretionary placements.

Mitigating Factors: The district <u>must</u> consider self-defense, intent, and a student's disciplinary history in deciding whether to order out-of-school suspension, removal to a District Alternative Education Program (DAEP), or expulsion, <u>regardless of whether the decision involves a</u> <u>mandatory or discretionary action [TEC 37.001(a)(4)]</u>. Law permits an administrator to override the requirements of the law; however, it is of utmost importance that all criminal activity be posted in e-School; and, if the requirements are overridden the campus must document the reason for this action and post in e-school as an **Action Code 28** (Mandatory Disciplinary Action was not taken as result of Student Code of Conduct). If the decision to not send a student to DAEP (for discretionary or mandatory reasons) by the ARD committee, admin must document the reason for this action and post in e-school as an **Action Code 27** (Mandatory Disciplinary Action was not taken as result of ARD Committee Hearing).

When determining the length of placement in the DAEP setting, such factors shall also be considered by the administrator:

- the student's intent or lack of intent,
- the student's discipline history,
- self-defense, and
- a disability that substantially impairs the student's capacity to appreciate the wrongfulness of the student's conduct.

<u>Special Education Students:</u> Adherence to Special Education laws, regulations, and procedures are required if the student has been identified as a student receiving Special Education services. (Contact the Special Services Department if you need assistance.)

<u>Section 504 Students:</u> Adherence to laws, regulations, and procedures related to accommodations under the Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 are required for qualified students with disabilities. (Contact the Coordinator for Section 504 and Dyslexic Services if you need assistance.)

## **Important Notes**

Campus Behavior Coordinator: A school district is required to appoint one campus behavior coordinator per campus to be responsible for maintaining student discipline and implementing discipline management techniques. The duties of the campus behavior coordinator may be executed by a designee if the coordinator is unavailable or unable to promptly address the situation. [TEC 37.0012]

**Procedures:** Before a student is removed from the regular classroom setting, school officials must typically follow an established procedure. The formality of these proceeding varies according to the seriousness of the penalty; for example, the Texas Education Code includes procedures for a conference in the case of a DAEP placement and a formal due process hearing in the case of an expulsion. For more detail on the required procedures, see the FO series of policies and the Student Code of Conduct.

**Temporary Placement:** Pending expulsion or DAEP placement, a student may be placed in ISS, out-of-school suspension for up to 3 days, or another appropriate placeman in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct.

**Notice of Student Discipline:** The campus behavior coordinator is required to provide prompt notice to a parent or guardian of a student who is placed in ISS, out-of-school suspension, DAEP, JJAEP or is taken into custody by law enforcement. This notice must be provided by telephone or in writing. If the coordinator is unable to make contact with the parent or guardian by 5pm of the first business day after the day of the disciplinary action was taken, the coordinator must mail written notice to the parent or guardian. [TEC 37.0012]

**Notice of Educational Opportunities:** The district is required to provide notice to the parent of a student who's has been removed to DAEP of the opportunity to complete coursework required for graduation and any available methods to obtain coursework. [TEC 37.008 (I-1)].

**Length of Removal:** The district's Student Code of Conduct includes guidelines on the length of a removal to DAEP or an expulsion. [TEC 37.001 (a)(5)].

**New Students**: If a student withdraws from school before an order of an expulsion or DAEP is entered, the district may complete the proceedings and enter the order. If the student reenrolls in the district during the same or the subsequent school year, the district may enforce the order, reduced for time served. If the student enrolls in another school district, the new district may honor the order, or, if the preceding district failed to enter an order, the new district may complete the proceedings and enter an order. [TEC 37.009(i)].

**Old Misconduct:** School officials are permitted, but not required to remove students for mandatory DAEP misconduct if school official did not learn of the conduct for more than one ear after the conduct occurred. [TEC 37.006(n)].

Elementary Students: Students younger than 10 must receive service in DAEP if the engage in expellable misconduct. [TEC 37.007 (e)(3), (h)]. However, a student younger than 6 (must have turned 6 by 9/1 of that school year) may not be sent to a DAEP unless the student brings a firearm to school under TEC 37.007 (e)(2). [TEC 37.006(l)]. Students om grades 2 and below may not be placed in out-of-school suspension unless the student engages in misconduct that is drug or alcohol related or that contains the elements of certain weapons offense or violent

offense under the Texas Penal Code. [TEC 37.005]. A district may adopt and implement a positive behavior program as an alternative to traditional discipline for students below third grade. [TEC 37.0013]

**Special Education Students:** Special state and federal laws apply to the discipline of special education students. See policy FOF(LEGAL) and the Student Code of Conduct.

#### **DAEP Referral Process:**

- 1. The school administrator starts the investigation of the offense by interviewing the student and relevant witnesses. Review and Chapter 37 to identify the misconduct and decide appropriate consequences. Notify the parent(s) that a conference is needed to recommend a DAEP placement, contacting the authorities (if applicable). In addition, call the Davis school to inform them of a potential DAEP placement.
- 2. The school administrator will send a copy of the *Letter to Parents Scheduling DAEP Conference* letter home, during which time the student may be suspended up to 3 days or assigned to ISS while arrangements are being made for the parent conference, but this is **not** a requirement if there is no safety concern. At no time should a student be suspended more than three (3) consecutive days, nor be placed in an in-school suspension for more than ten (10) consecutive days pending a DAEP placement.
  - If SPED/504 or suspicion of disability, schedule a staffing with district personnel prior to the MDR.
- 3. The Campus Discipline Committee, led by the Campus Behavior Coordinator Discipline (CBC), meets with the parent (and student, if applicable) to review the investigation findings. Notes from this meeting will be documented on the *DAEP Conference Report Form*. If the administrator has documented a "good faith" effort (*minimum of 3 phone calls*, a hand-delivered notice, a certified letter, and/or an e-mail) to inform the student and the student's parent of the date, time and location of the conference, the school administrator may proceed with the conference even in the absence of the student and parent(s). If the parent agrees with the decision of the CBC's recommendation for a DAEP placement, the parent signs the *DAEP Placement and letter to parent* form then go to Step 5. If the parent is not in agreement with the recommendation, go to Step 4.
  - If SPED/504 or suspicion of disability, conduct a MDR/504 meeting and the change of Placement ARD if warranted. Include the appropriate representative from the DAEP campus.
- 4. If the parent is not in agreement with the Campus Discipline Committee's recommendation for a DAEP placement, the parent may file in accordance with FNG Local (see O:Davis School). After receipt of the appeal request, the appropriate administrator shall investigate as necessary and schedule a conference with the student or parent after receipt of the written complaint. If the administrator has documented a "good faith" effort (see above)) to inform the student and the student's parent of the date, time and location of the conference, the school administrator may proceed with the conference even in the absence of the student and parent(s). If it is decided that a DAEP placement is appropriate, go on to Step 5. If it is decided that the DAEP placement is not appropriate, the student shall remain at the home campus.

- 5. If DAEP Placement agreement has been reached, a transition meeting is to be set-up regarding the Davis School (use *Davis School* (*DAEP*) *Review Form*). Input discipline action into eSchool. Inform your registrar that the student will be attending the Davis School.
  - Send Davis School (via email) the following documents: **DAEP Placement Order and Letter to Parents, eSchool Discipline** incident form (w/DAEP indicated), **Davis School (DAEP) Review Form**, and the **Criminal Trespass Notice**.
- 6. The Davis School will enroll the student after all documents have been received and after the student and guardian attends the Davis Orientation.

## \*\*TRESSPASSING - Texas Education Code 37.107

To be eligible to return to the home campus, a student must complete the term of his or her placement in the DAEP set by the principal of the campus on which the offense occurred. An unauthorized person who trespasses on the grounds of the District commits a Class C misdemeanor. (Education Code 37.107)

The progress of all students being served in a DAEP placement will be reviewed every 15 to 30 days of successful behavioral intervention and assigned durations may be lessened at that time if deemed appropriate by the District's Discipline Committee unless mandated by policy.
