2022-2023 Davis School (DAEP) Review Form

The Lester Davis School is the disciplinary alternative school of the Denton Independent School District. This highly structured school provides behavior management and social skills training along with teaching the core academic curriculum.

Mandatory Student Orientation/Guardian Involvement

Student and guardian are advised to arrive no later than 8:00 AM on ___/___, at 1125 Davis St., Denton Tx. Students accompanied by parent or guardian may enroll in the DAEP on Tuesday or Thursday mornings at 8:20 am. No one may be enrolled without attending this hour and a half session.

- No one will be admitted after the session has begun.
- **Student + 2 people maximum may attend**. One attendee must be a guardian (ID check will be conducted to confirm guardianship).
- ****Current CDC Guidelines will be required** of all orientation attendees.

Orientation expectations:

- Student must be in Davis Dress Code (see page 2 for details) (students may not be allowed to stay at school on the 1st day if they are out of dress code).
- Students will ride the Davis School bus to their assigned bus stop at the end of the school day (bus stops will be assigned during orientation).
- Students should bring enough money for breakfast and lunch for the week (details listed below).
- Orientation will last approximately an hour and half.

FAQ's

DAEP Daily Expectations?

- Each student will walk through a metal detector and have a clothing and grooming inspection every day.
- All students will follow the Davis Dress Code. See page 2 for details.
- Students may not bring cell phones, computers, or any data device to Davis School.
- Students will ride the Davis School bus to school each day (excluding the morning of orientation). Parents will choose bus stops at orientation. A list of bus stops is also on the Davis webpage.
- Student cooperation is expected; no one may disrupt the teaching/learning environment.
- Attendance at 90% or above is mandatory. Court referrals may be triggered for truancy issues.
- Students may be assessed for substance abuse.
- Students will participate in character building and counseling classes.

Breakfast and Lunch?

- Students will receive breakfast and lunch at The Lester Davis School.
- Students will not be able to bring their own breakfast or lunch.
- Any money in existing school lunch accounts will be available to the student. All assisted lunch enrollment transfers from your home campus (i.e. free or reduced lunch).
- Weekly meal prices, including breakfast and lunch: Full pay = **\$24.50** Reduced = **\$3.50** Free = **\$0.00** Medication and hygiene?
- The school nurse will administer prescription drugs.
- No-over-the counter medications will be given without an MD's orders.
- Parents must transport medications, do not send with student. Some accommodations may be made with proper documentation and consultation with administration and nurse.
- Feminine hygiene products will be provided as needed.

Davis Dress Code 2022-2023

All students at Davis School are held responsible to follow the Davis School dress code. Administration has final say of the dress code.

• Clothing:

- Students will wear solid white, black or gray shirts free of logos, colored threading, decoration, pictures or writing.
 - Shirts may be short or long sleeved, crew neck, button down, or tee (no v-necks/scoop necks).
 - Shirts must fit properly and be worn properly.
 - Shirts will be tucked so that the waistband is revealed at all times.
 - A pullover sweatshirt, white, black or gray, may be worn for warmth over the white, black, or gray shirts.
 - No hoodies, strings, zippers or logos are allowed on the sweatshirt.
- Students will wear plain blue jeans (not acid washed or bleached) fitted at the waist without a belt.
 - o Pants will be worn at the waist and fit properly (NO skintight, sagging or dragging).
 - Pant cuffs must be properly hemmed and may not touch the floor when shoes are off.
 - NO wide leg, skinny/jeggings, or belled pants.
 - Pants will be free of decorations (NO stripes, pictures or large writing).
 - No gym shorts or leggings may be worn under the jeans.
- Students will wear white, black and/or gray socks (no other colors allowed).
- Students will wear white, black and/or gray athletic shoes (no other colors allowed).
- Student's clothing will be neat with no stains, rips, tears, or holes.
- Students will not wear see-through or form-fitting clothes.
- Underwear/undergarments (male or female) must not be visible through the clothing.
- Any jacket or hoodie worn on the school bus to school will be removed upon entering the building. Any shirts, sweatshirts, jackets, or coats worn to and from school must avoid any gang representation.
- No extra items or clothing items are permitted on the bus or at school.
- Grooming:
 - Hair:
 - Hair must be clean, controlled, and out of the student's eyes.
 - No mohawks or spikes are allowed.
 - Cloth/elastic scrunchies & headbands must be black, white and/or gray.
 - No hair clips, hair fasteners or bobby pins are allowed.
 - Nails may not extend beyond the fingertip. Clear nail polish may be worn.
 - Students must cover tattoos, hickeys, body markings, or intentional scarring.
 - Students have the option to wear natural makeup.
 - Students may not wear jewelry/spacers (If these items are brought to school they will be confiscated).
 - Students may not wear any type of head covering in the building or on buses.
- Other:
 - Students at the Lester Davis School will clear through a metal detector every morning.
 - Purses and backpacks are not allowed at school.
 - Do not bring cell phones, computers or any data device to the Lester Davis School.
 - Confiscated items may be picked up in the office by a parent during normal business hours (7:15 3:15).
 - The Lester Davis School is not responsible for any loss or stolen items brought to school.
